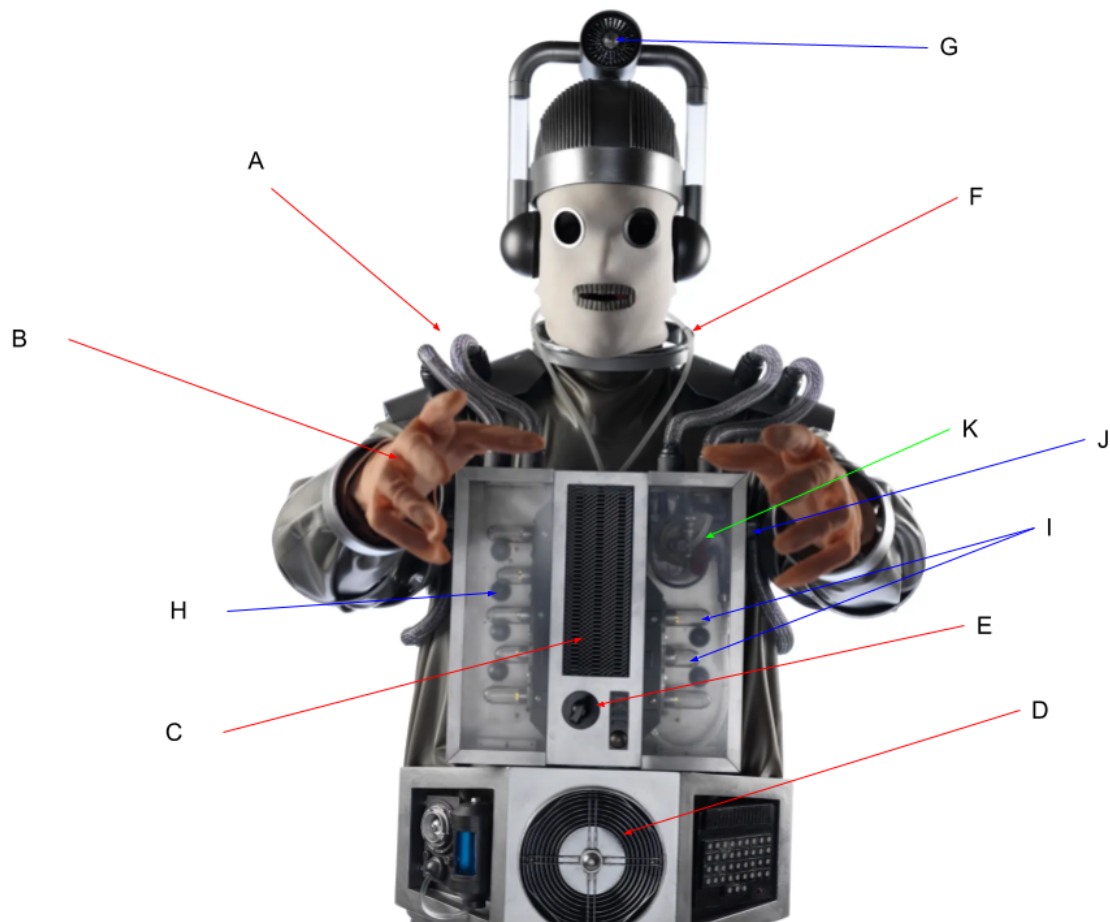





F	Polyurethane/Polyethylene Tube	As I'm unsure of the diameter I'm leaving this portion blank.
G	My current working theory is that this is some form of metal sink strainer. Still have no idea what the exact brand could be. The picture is of a similar type. A notable detail is that the object has 30 holes going around the diameter,	
H	I believe these are some form of audio dome knob, similar to the chicken head knobs. Picture is of a similar type.	
I	Some form of lightbulbs, one shorter than the other. I've heard they're Lucas brand, but still unknown.	
J	Appears to be some form of plumbing/pipe part - has mounting ears, and a pipe thread attached to it. Used throughout the main Cyber-body.
