


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Dear *Star Trek* fan,

We sat down with the Brand Manager on the *U.S.S. Enterprise* project, Travis, and asked him to answer a few questions. Enjoy the interview and stay tuned for more updates coming later this year!

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The replica is MASSIVE! Why the 1:350 scale?

Great question! We decided to go with the ginormous 1:350 scale because it's the preferred scale for most sci-fi modelers and collectors. And let's be honest, this thing is going to look super awesome as the centerpiece of any *Star Trek* collection (or ANY collection for that matter)!

What is the process working with Paramount?

We could not have asked for a better partnership than the one we have with **Paramount**. They loved the idea of the large scale, premium crowdsource collectible from day one, and they've been a huge help throughout the entire journey. Projects of this magnitude usually start with a rough concept and once that's approved, we move to a sales model (which many of you saw in our early Facebook Live videos). After that is approved, we proceed with the building of the tool model. Once **Paramount** approves that, then we can start making the actual molds out of steel. In a few months we will send the deco model (which is comprised of ~500 hand painted operations) to **Paramount** for approval. I can't wait to see the first deco samples because of the intricate paint ops!

Can you share any sneak peeks?

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What's your favorite feature of the *U.S.S. Enterprise*?

Of course, you would ask that question! This is a tough one to answer because I feel this replica of the iconic *U.S.S. Enterprise* is the definitive version, but I'll try to narrow my favorites to a few features.

- As mentioned before, I'm a huge fan of the paint operations that faithfully replicate the details found on the screen-used model that is currently on display at the **Smithsonian Institute**.
- My second favorite feature is the light sequencing and I only say that because I know how much dedication and work Chris (and our project engineers) put into the electronic flowchart.
